## Water meter readings

The Town is currently working on the billing of the annual water tax. In order to ensure the accurate billing of your water consumption, it is important that your meter reading be submitted to us by September 27th 2012. You may submit your reading to us by any of the following means:

- By mail, by completing the card mailed to you on September 7th
- By dropping your completed card off directly at the Town Hall (after hours, cards may be left in the mail slot located at the front door)
- By phone, by dialing 514-485-8941 (If calling after hours, please state clearly your meter reading, your name, address and telephone number)

A \$50 service charge will apply to accounts for which readings are not received by the due date (By-law 41 8-4 concerning the Regulation of Sewers and the Supply of Water in the Town of Montreal West).
