Westminster - Traffic Calming

Please be advised that there is construction work scheduled to take place on Westminster beginning early in the month of July. The traffic calming work will involve the installation of curb extensions at the intersections of Westminster/Parkside and Westminster/Curzon. The duration of the work is anticipated to last two to three weeks. As a result of the construction work, traffic delays in the area are expected. A subsequent notice will be sent to all residents and businesses in the area a week before the work begins and will outline the full scope of the work and the parking and circulation impact on residents and businesses in the area.

Northview - sidewalk replacement

Please be advised that sidewalk replacement on Northview (near Elizabeth Ballantyne School) is planned for the beginning of August. The work should take two weeks to complete. During the work residents in the affected area may temporarily lose access to their driveways. As a definitive start date approaches, a subsequent letter will be distributed listing the temporary parking locations for the affected residents.

Garden and landscape waste, dead leaves.

New: Conifers small branches

Small branches of conifers (cedar, fir, pine, spruce, etc.) no more than 1 meter long and 5 centimeters in diameter, tied in bundles are now accepted in the green waste collection on the above indicated dates. Outside of this period, these branches will be allowed in the garbage collection.

Excluded green waste

Table waste, soil and stone, pet litter and waste, as well as conifer branches longer than 1 meter or whose diameter exceeds 5 cm and branches of deciduous trees (maple oak, poplar, etc.).

Containers

The only accepted containers are paper bags, unwaxed cardboard boxes or any other reusable rigid container.
