Dear neighbours and residents of Montreal West,

SAFETY

A friendly reminder that the town is proceeding to its spring cleanup. We need the collaboration from residents regarding the seasonal parking restrictions on certain public streets until Nov 15. Our Public safety officers gave out multiple warnings during the current month. Please be aware that you will be ticketed if you are parked illegally during restricted parking hours.

The spring period for using your electric blower is coming to an end on May 1. Your next opportunity to use your blower will be in the fall from Nov 1st to the 30th.

The annual emergency siren test organized by Montreal Civil Protection will take place on Wednesday, May 6, 2026, from 9:30 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. in Montreal West. The Lactalis Canada plant, located at 7470 Saint-Jacques Street West in Montreal, uses ammonia. In the event of an industrial accident involving the release of ammonia into the air, the plant's warning siren would quickly alert the population that could be potentially exposed.
