### **SAFETY**

At the request from residents on Rugby place, council passed a new bylaw, a 2 hour parking restriction Tuesday mornings for street cleaning.

Dog walking season is officially upon us, which means I'll be crossing many of you while strolling through town with my very own Coco Chanel. Here are a few bylaws and etiquette reminders to keep tails wagging and the neighbourhood peaceful:

- Dogs must be on a leash at all times in public spaces.
- Public parks are not dog parks. For off-leash fun, the town has a beautiful dog park right behind Town Hall — it's fenced, it's lovely, and your dog will lose their mind in the best way.
- Please do not leave your dog tied up alone outside while running errands. Beyond the risk of theft, a stressed dog is a loud and unpredictable dog.
- No animals are permitted in public buildings.
- Please pick up after your dog. Every single time. You don't want to end up as "a most wanted list" on the resident's FB page!
- Register your pet (dog or cat) with the town! If your furry escape artist ever makes a break for it, our PSOs can reunite you quickly.
