FOLLOW-UP NOTICE: COURTNEY DRIVE RECONSTRUCTION

Work on the municipal land between Ronald and Courtney

Infrastructure work on Courtney Drive is progressing as planned. The next phase will involve the replacement and rehabilitation of the sewer and water main pipes located on the municipal land between Ronald and Courtney (circled in yellow).



Schedule

Work in this area is scheduled to begin on Monday, August 3 and is expected to last approximately 4 weeks. Please note that the schedule may change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

Working hours

Work will generally take place from Monday to Friday, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Some weekends or extended hours may occur if required.

Traffic and access

Ronald Drive will be restricted to local traffic only, with vehicle access maintained for residents for the duration of the work.

Beginning August 3, a portion of Ronald Drive will be fully closed to through traffic for approximately 2 weeks. During this period, motorists will still be able to access their homes, but they will be required to enter and exit the area using the same route. A clearly signed detour route will be in place.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times, and safe passage around the work area will be clearly marked.



What to expect during construction

Residents can expect:

- Noise and vibration from construction equipment
- Dust and temporary debris
- Increased construction vehicle traffic

The contractor will take measures to minimize disruptions wherever possible.

Project management

A Town-employed representative from engineering firm Avizo Experts Conseils Inc. will always be on the construction site. You can call or email Public Works during regular business hours to be put in touch with the project supervisor.
