

## Eastern Larch

*Larix laricina*

**Type:** Conifer native to Quebec

**Mature height:** Approximately 20 metres

**Mature width:** Approximately 10 metres

**Exposure:** Full sun

**General characteristics:** A very hardy conifer well adapted to Québec's climatic conditions. It is distinguished by its soft, light green needles, which turn golden yellow in the fall. Tolerant of various soil types, soil compaction, and de-icing salts, it is an attractive choice for properties with sufficient space.

**Minimum safe distance from power lines:** 7 metres

## White Spruce

*Picea glauca*

**Type:** Native conifer of Québec

**Mature Height:** Approximately 22 metres

**Mature Width:** Approximately 10 metres

**Sun Exposure:** Full sun to partial shade

**General Characteristics:** A robust and hardy conifer, well adapted to Québec's climatic conditions. It offers excellent landscape and ecological value, particularly for wildlife, while maintaining evergreen foliage year-round.

**Minimum Safe Distance from Power Lines:** 6.5 metres

## Bur Oak

*Quercus macrocarpa*

**Type:** Deciduous tree native to Quebec

**Mature height:** Approximately 20 metres

**Mature width:** Approximately 20 metres

**Exposure:** Full sun

**General characteristics:** A large, hardy, and very long-lived deciduous tree. Its deep root system and broad crown require a spacious property. Tolerant and low-maintenance, it provides excellent ecological value.

**Minimum safe distance from power lines:** 12.5 metres

## Common Hackberry

*Celtis occidentalis*

**Type:** Native deciduous tree of Québec

**Mature Height:** Approximately 15 metres

**Mature Width:** Approximately 8 metres

**Sun Exposure:** Full sun to partial shade

**General Characteristics:** A hardy, fast-growing tree that is particularly well adapted to urban environments. It tolerates pollution, road salt, and a wide variety of soil conditions.

**Minimum Safe Distance from Power Lines:** 5.5 metres

## Nannyberry

*Viburnum lentago*

**Type:** Small fruit-bearing tree native to Quebec

**Mature height:** Approximately 6 metres

**Mature width:** Approximately 3 metres

**Exposure:** Full sun to partial shade

**General characteristics:** A hardy, low-maintenance small tree. Its spring flowers and edible fruit provide both ornamental and ecological value. Tolerant of pollution and urban conditions, it is well suited to smaller residential properties.

**Minimum safe distance from power lines:** No restriction

## American Hophornbeam

*Ostrya virginiana*

**Type:** Deciduous tree native to Quebec

**Mature height:** Approximately 12 metres

**Mature width:** Approximately 8 metres

**Exposure:** Full sun, partial shade, or shade

**General characteristics:** A small, hardy and robust tree that tolerates urban conditions well. Its elegant form, distinctive bark, and golden-yellow fall foliage give it outstanding ornamental appeal.

**Minimum safe distance from power lines:** 5 metres
